- EMS Rep Sharon Hoier discussed news regarding the EMS system
Highlights: CHOC is now a pediatric trauma receiving center, EMR changes, Paramedic Pilot Program, CCRU: paramedics with an NP has been approved in Anaheim, OCPD will be able to deliver narkan (INH piloted program), LB Memorial is trauma resource for LA, Psych pt transports will go directly to psych facility – possibly coming soon.
