Gary Sparger was a founder of many educational initiatives in the Orange Coast and Greater LA ENA chapters. He was among the first teaching CEN review courses and a resource for emergency nursing education. As an active ENA member his passing in 1985 led to a loss of an incredible resource. In his memory the scholarship is available for \$500 to one qualified applicant who is seeking to further his or her nursing education to a baccalaureate degree or higher in nursing. The scholarship may also be divided between two (2) or more applicants at the discretion of the Chapter Board of Directors.

- A. Any California ENA member may apply
- B. Applicants must submit:
 - 1) ENA membership card
 - 2) RN license as LVN or RN in State of California
 - 3) Enrolled in a National League of Nursing accredited school with proof of enrollment of acceptance
 - 4) Curriculum Vitae
 - 5) Current Certification proof- CEN, CPEN, MICN
 - 6) Letter of Intent to include answer to these questions:
 - a) How the profession of Emergency Nursing will benefit from your education
 - b) Your involvement in ENA including all offices held or positions which you have been appointed

- D. The Chapter Board of Directors will review all applications and select recipient(s). Awards will be presented at the August 18, 2018 meeting and conference
- E. Members may receive one scholarship for each degree they pursue
